2. As the Senior Commander for the United States Army Cyber Center of Excellence and Fort Gordon, I am the Safety Officer for this installation. It is my responsibility to set the safety priorities for all Fort Gordon installation activities.

3. Commanders, supervisors, and managers are responsible for ensuring a safe working and living environment for our Service Members, employees, and their families. I will accept nothing less than the direct and personal involvement of all leaders in the installation safety program. The organizational safety program enhances mission readiness. Leadership's direct involvement in safety reduces accidents.

4. In our day-to-day routines, our success is centered on how well we accomplish the fundamentals. Risk management is fundamental to success in all of our operations, ranging from systems development, training, deployments, and recreation. The greatest killer of our personnel is driving privately owned vehicles, both on and off duty. Accidents can be avoided with Risk Management.

5. I have directed the Command Safety Director to manage and coordinate with all units on Fort Gordon and Gillem Enclave to execute my safety program across all activities. Inform the Installation Safety Office of any and all safety related issues.

6. We all are responsible to protect our greatest asset – the American Soldier, Sailor, Airman, Marine, Civilian, Contractor and their families. I want everyone engaged – take charge at home and work. Be safe!
