MEMORANDUM FOR FORT GORDON PERSONNEL

SUBJECT: Commanding General's Policy Memorandum No. 19 – Fraternalization Policy

1. REFERENCES:

- a. Army Regulation 600-20, Chapter 4-14 & 15, Army Command Policy, 6 November 2014
- b. TRADOC Regulation 350-6, Chapter 2-6 and 4-8, Enlisted Initial Entry Training Policies and Administration, 7 November 2013
- c. TRADOC Regulation 350-36, Chapter 4-3, Basic Officer Leader Training Policies and Administration, 13 January 2014
- d. TRADOC Pamphlet 600-4, Chapter 9-3, The Soldier's Blue Book, 27 October 2014

2. In addition to the above references which define "Fraternalization", "Professional Relationships", "Unprofessional Relationships", "Improper Relationships", and other prohibited relationships (which include, but are not limited to: Trainee-Trainee relationships; Cadre-Trainee relationships; Trainee-Permanent Party relationships, regardless of installation or assignment of either party; etc.), this policy includes IET Soldiers and Soldiers in any level of Professional Military Education (PME), whether Enlisted, Warrant Officer, or Commissioned Officer.

3. Any relationship between permanent party and/or cadre personnel (regardless of rank or civilian grade) and Soldiers in a training status (regardless of rank) not required by the training mission is prohibited. This includes situations where the cadre and the student hold the same rank.

4. Any relationship between Soldiers in a training status not in compliance with the referenced regulations and not required by the training mission is prohibited. This includes IET Soldiers and PME Soldiers regardless of rank.

5. Violations of this policy may subject offender to administrative action or be punished under the Uniform Code Military Justice.

6. This policy is in effect until superseded or rescinded.
