SUBJECT: Termination of Evacuation Order for all U.S. Army personnel assigned to Cyber Center of Excellence and Fort Eisenhower, GA, tenant units and their dependents residing in areas affected by Hurricane Helene 2024

1. Effective Thursday, October 10, 2024, at 11:59 p.m., I am terminating the Limited Evacuation Order issued on September 29, 2024 for all permanent party personnel and families assigned to U.S. Army units and joint-service tenant units on Fort Eisenhower, GA .
2. Unit commanders and supervisors remain responsible for maintaining accountability and determining individual duty status, within applicable laws and regulations. Commanders will ensure unit personnel update location and accountability information in applicable disaster accountability databases (i.e. Army Disaster Accountability & Assessment System and joint service equivalents).
3. All evacuation allowances will cease upon termination of this evacuation order with the exception of return travel entitlements. Personnel who evacuated to a safe haven location less than 360 miles from FEGA are authorized one day after termination of the evacuation order to return to base. Personnel who found a safe haven location between 360 and 500 miles of FEGA are authorized up to two days to return to base. Personnel will seek guidance from their chain of command or supervisor on return travel plans and entitlements under the Joint Travel Regulation. The Cyber Center of Excellence will issue further information on the claims process through chains-of-command in separate correspondence and orders.
