The use of illicit drugs to include cannabis and cannabis-related substances is prohibited by all military services, Active Duty, Reservist, National Guard, and Department of Defense (DoD) civilian employees. Cannabis in all forms to include THC, and CBD, is prohibited. All soldiers are subject to UA (Urine Analysis) upon return of travel.
