

## Required Assessments

ASSESSMENT	REQUIREMENT	GUIDANCE
<b>Command Climate Survey</b>	AR 600-20, p.101	Company commanders (company-level equivalents) will administer the Command Climate within 90 days (Active Army) or 180 days (Army National Guard, U.S. Army Reserve) of assuming command and annually thereafter. At their discretion company commanders may administer the survey more often and may also use additional survey instruments to assess the unit climate. <i>The survey is voluntary for commanders above company level.</i>
<b>Unit Risk Inventory (URI)</b>  POC: Risk Reduction Program Coordinator	AR 600-85, p.80	Commanders will coordinate with the installation ASAP to administer the Unit Risk Inventory (URI) to all deploying Soldiers at least 30 days before an operational deployment.
<b>Reintegration Risk Inventory (RURI)</b>  POC:	AR 600-85, p.80	Commanders will coordinate with the installation ASAP to administer the R-URI to redeploying Soldiers between 90 and 180 days of their return from deployment.
<b>Global Assessment Tool (GAT)</b>		The GAT is mandatory for all Soldiers. The GAT can be accessed at: <a href="https://www.army.mil/csf/">https://www.army.mil/csf/</a> .

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<b>FORSCOM Soldier Risk Policy Tool</b>		This tool will be used by all commands to classify and transmit information on at-risk Soldiers. The worksheet can be found on the FORSCOM portal. Leaders will complete the FSRPT on all Soldiers currently assigned to their formations within 30 days.
<b>Pre-Deployment Health Assessment (PreDHA)</b>	DoDI 6490.03, p. 21; DD Form 2795	Pre-Deployment Health Assessment. DD Form 2795 must be confirmed as current within 60 days prior to the expected deployment date.
<b>Post-Deployment Health Assessment (PostDHA)</b>	DoDI 6490.03, p. 27; DD Form 2796	Completed 30 prior to redeployment or immediately upon return. The DD Form 2796 is required if a DD Form 2795 was required during the pre-deployment phase
<b>Post-Deployment Health Reassessment (PDHRA)</b>  POC: Personnel Staff Officers (G1/S1)	DODI 6490.03, p. 29; DD Form 2900	Complete DD Forms 2900, "Post-Deployment Health Reassessment (PDHRA)," when required. A DD Form 2900 will be administered to each redeployed individual within 90 to 180 days after return to home station from a deployment that required completion of a post-deployment health assessment.
